

POLSAT PLUS ARENA GDAŃSK STADIUM

SIGHTSEEING REGULATIONS

PARKING

1. We invite you to the reception desk of the Polsat Plus Arena Gdańsk stadium, where the tours begin.
2. Parking P3 and P4 near the stadium secretariat, which is available for passenger cars for the first 30 minutes paid PLN 1, second 30 min. paid PLN 2, then the first and each subsequent hour PLN 3. P3-A car parks for coaches payable first and next 2 hours of parking 10 PLN / h, a day 40 PLN. Failure to pay for a parking ticket costs PLN 95. Payment can be made at the automatic parking counter located in the parking lot, and the purchased parking ticket should be left in the car behind the windshield in a visible place. Parking P3 and P4 is free of charge for electric cars (with green signs).
3. The stadium can also be reached by public transport. From the center of Gdańsk you can get here by tram number 10 or number 7, from Gdańsk Wrzeszcz by bus number 158. Get off at the "Stadion" stop.

INFORMATION ABOUT TOURS

1. Tours start at the main reception desk of the Stadium Secretariat. You should allocate about 60 minutes for the tour.
2. The time for visiting the Stadium included in the booking confirmation is the time when the tour starts. Please be 10 minutes before the indicated time.
3. **Please be punctual, in case of delay the tour may be shortened, moved to another hour or canceled if there are a large number of people enrolled on the day.** In case of any delays related to the arrival for the tour or the cancellation of the tour, please inform us (by e-mail or telephone) at least one hour before the start of the tour. Otherwise, the tickets will expire.
4. Visiting Polsat Plus Arena Gdańsk is available to people with valid tickets.
5. Ticket prices for guided tours of the stadium:

- tour with guide - PLN 25 / person
 - group ticket (up to 50 people, including attendants) - PLN 950 / group,
 - ticket for a disabled person - PLN 15 / person,
 - children under 4 - free.
6. Ticket price for the viewpoint:
 - viewpoint ticket - PLN 15 / person
 7. Opening hours for guided tours
 - in the period from May 1 to September 30, from from 10 A.M. to 6 P.M. (last admission at 6 P.M.),
 - in the period from October 1 to April 30, from from 10 A.M to 4 P.M. (last admission at 3 P.M.).
 8. Viewpoint opening hours
 - from May 1 to September 30, from from 10 A.M. to 6 P.M.
 - from October 1 to April 30, from from 10 A.M. to 4 P.M.
 9. The guide can take a group of 50 people for a maximum of one hour.
 10. There are over a hundred steps on the tour, so we recommend that you wear comfortable shoes. It is not possible to move with a pram.
 11. In order to adjust the sightseeing route, it is necessary to notify in advance that disabled people will want to participate in the tour.
 12. The tour takes place only with the guide conducting the tour, do not separate from the group. In case of loss, try to contact the closest stadium staff person or another guide.
 13. During the tour, follow the instructions given by the tour guide or another Operator's employee.
 14. Toilets for visitors are located around the reception area. The toilets will be closed during the tour.
 15. It is forbidden to bring animals on the premises of Polsat Plus Arena Gdańsk. It is allowed to bring a guide dog for a disabled person.
 16. The organizer reserves the right to postpone or cancel the visit due to ongoing football training sessions or mass events.
 17. Otherwise, the provisions of the Regulations of the Polsat Plus Arena Gdańsk Stadium apply.
